While "The Knights of Evernaught" game is a

completely made-up game, some of you will recognize the setting, which copies the Mario Bros. video game. In this game, Mario is an Italian, overalls-wearing plumber who travels through plumbing pipes to rescue Princess Peach whenever she gets kidnapped by the notorious villain, Bowser. These characters are thinly disguised in our play as Mária, Princess Plum, and Browzer. The Mario games include chain chomps, which are fearsome steel balls with snapping jaws that make life harder for Mario.

The heroes are joined by Sumas, who is like Samus Aran from the game, *Metroid*. She is a bounty hunter who hunts space pirates, outfitted in her high-tech Power Suit and arm cannon. Link (our Lonk) is a heroic character from a game called, *Legend of Zelda*, and looks kind of like Robin Hood.

Queen Candy is the sugary-sweet villain in our game, *I* whose ideal of ultimate villainy is to kidnap Princess Plum. In our world, she amasses a team of villains from various games. You'll see Carmen SanFrancisco, who is based on the educational video game called, *Where in the World Is Carmen SanDiego?* from the 80's and 90's which tried to teach geography to children by having them follow this dastardly thief as she traveled the world stealing colossal monuments, like the Great Pyramids or the Great Wall of China.

Another of our villains, Browzer, is inspired by Bowser, the princess-kidnapper in the Mario Bros games. He is a scary, fire-breathing, turtle-esque creature. You've probably guessed that Monkey Kong comes from the *Donkey Kong* games, but did you know that in his first appearance, Donkey Kong was

a villain? The protagonist was none other than Mario, who wouldn't get his own game until four years later. Donkey Kong is a giant gorilla who throws barrels. Shadow is from a game called, *Sonic the Hedgehog*, where he's an anti-hero with a tragic back story. In our play, Slenderman comes from a real urban legend that

started in 2009: details on Slenderman are hazy, but people are aren't supposed to look into his face, as it is terrifying.

In our play this year, a number of Pokemon appear. *Pokemon* began as

Nintendo Game Boy video game with about 150 little monsters, called "Pokemon." In this game, the Pokemon creatures like Eevees and Pikachu are animals, and you play a 10-year-old who embarks on a quest to capture and train these creatures for battle. *Pokemon Go!* started in 2016 as a mobile augmented reality

incarnation of this game, where your iphone's camera works with the game to allow you to "see" the otherwise invisible Pokemon that seem to actually be floating or flitting around near you, wherever you are. After spotting a

Pokemon who might be just a few feet away from you, you can use your phone to throw pokeballs to capture them.

Angry birds is a game where you use a slingshot to shoot colorful birds at angry pigs to try to knock down their towers.

... and believe it or not, our top-hat wearing, heartspewing, rainbow-streaming, purple flying hippo is an actual cheat code from *Age of Mythology*. Typing in "WuvWoo" summons this incredibly powerful creature to help out.

Our 6th graders this year play video game characters who have escaped from a variety of different video games. You might recognize Kirby, Lucina, Mine Craft Steve, Palutena, Pig King, Toon Link, and Red Toad!

... and Microsoft Word users may remember screaming at your computers at Clippy, the annoying paperclip who offered pointless, unwanted assistance a little too often!
