ABOUT THE THURSTON PLAYERS

In 1974, a group of Thurston Elementary School parents decided to write and perform an original musical to benefit the PTO. This organization became what the Thurston Players are today.

In the beginning, the annual fundraiser was an "adults only" production—written, performed, and produced by Thurston parents and teachers, as well as neighbors and friends of the community. Students from Thurston Elementary were included in the cast in 1997, leading the way to add middle school, high school and even college-aged Thurston alumni cast members throughout the years!

Tonight's musical is the result of a full year of work by hundreds of dedicated people. Once this year's musical comes to an end, there will be a brief break until the Players are back in session to create the 2020 production. The Script and Lyrics Committees will get their creative juices flowing to craft a new musical, ready for auditions in October.

Anyone affiliated with Thurston Elementary School can be in or work for the musical—nobody is "cut" from the team, provided they (the children and the children's parents) are willing to put in the time and effort. After auditions, parts are cast, and additional parts are created if needed. Parents of child actors and other willing adults are assigned to crew committees, such as publicity, advertising, make-up, refreshments, and ticket sales.

Three nights a week, the cast rehearses in the Clague Middle School Auditorium. Everyone involved works extremely hard to give their best performance and efforts. And if it wasn't obvious already, everyone has a whole lot of fun!

Then, before anyone realizes, it is showtime, and the wonderful bunch of neighbors—ranging from kindergartners to senior citizens—will be ready to link arms onstage and sing once again:

"That's all! That's our show for this year And we're glad that you all could be here!"

Many thousands of dollars have been raised for our neighborhood schools over the years. You are as much a part of this production as we are.

As we celebrate our 46th anniversary, thank you again....we are so glad that you are here!
